



### Risky Business in Risky World




### **Credit Management**

In the series of Online Guest Lectures, a session was organized by the School of Banking, Financial Services and Insurance Management on "Credit Management" on 24th April 2021 for MBA and BBA students. The Guest lecture was conducted by Mr. Rajendra Prasad Pattanayak, AGM (Retd.), Punjab National Bank. He introduced the topic by emphasizing the understanding of various important concepts about it. He discussed Credit rating cycle theory, various approaches used by banks for the safety of loans, Credit Risk management etc. He used real-life examples to explain the concepts. In the later part of the discussions, he deliberated on credit risk limits, various risk models used by Indian banks and RBI guidelines on credit exposure and management. The webinar ended with an interactive question and answer session.

### **Stock Market Trading**

A skill development session on "Stock Market Trading" was conducted by the School of Banking, Financial Services and Insurance Management on 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2021 for all MBA, BBA and B.Com students. 
